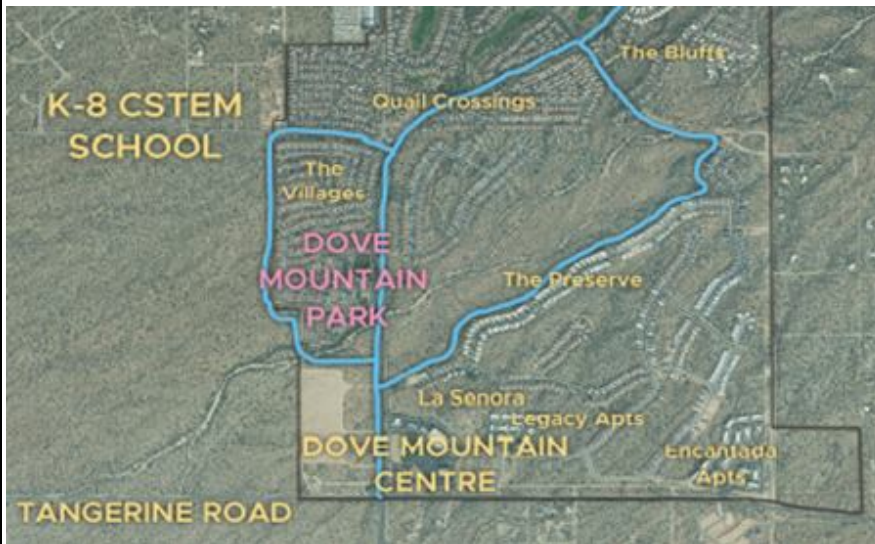

## Dove Mountain Trails

(Part Two in a Series)

**The Villages Loop Trail** can be accessed from the W. Moore Road trailhead or the DM Blvd West Trail across the road from the South Preserve West Gate. If you start from the W. Moore Road trailhead you'll head south along the west perimeter of the Villages Neighborhood and then drop down to the desert floor and then continue along the trail until it connects with the DM Blvd West Trail – great loop trail!

**Trail Maintenance:** The Preserve's *Homeowner Executive Advisory Committee* (HEAC) has sponsored a **South Preserve Trail Maintenance Project** that began in September. The project will restore two sections of the trail and then fine grade and stabilize the entire trail system. The project will also include the DM Blvd East Trail from the South Preserve West Gate to W. Moore Road. The project is expected to be completed in early October. **\*The walking trails mentioned are outlined in blue in the above photo.**

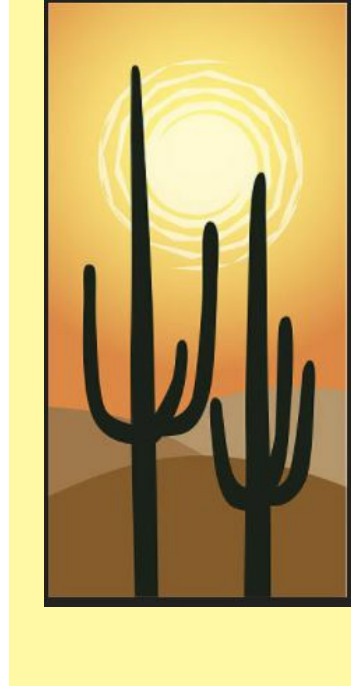
