Additional Homes on Dove Mountain

In 2012 the Town of Marana approved the construction of three developments and a fourth is under final review. The Encantada at Dove Mountain and the Dove Mountain Casitas (both apartments) and Tortolita Reserve (79 home lots) and Del Webb @ Dove Mountain (163 home lots).

Encantada and Tortolita Reserve are under construction. Mountain Casitas is approved and Del Webb is still in Marana Planning and Zoning. The existing subdivision of [Saguaro Forest](#) now has lots and roads under construction.

Dove Mountain Casitas, Saguaro Forest, and Del Webb are located at the north end of Dove Mountain Boulevard. Tortolita Reserve is

located west of The Highlands at Dove Mountain. Encatada at Dove Mountain has equipment working at Tangerine & Camino De Oeste.

Latest Development in Wastewater Battle Between Pima County and Marana

The Arizona Supreme Court has declined to hear the Town of Marana's case relating to a ballot measure that would have allowed the municipality to own and operate a wastewater facility without seeking voter approval in next year's town elections.

This marks the latest development in the battle between Pima County and Marana over control of the Marana involvement in the wastewater business, but a recent ruling by the Arizona Court of Appeals deemed that ballot question too vague, meaning Marana must now revise the question and again collect voter support before it can own and operate a wastewater facility.

Town Manager Gilbert Davidson said he expects to receive that support come Marana's election season in March 2013.
