Death Clouds on Mount Baldy (Cathy Hufault)
Heritage Highlands
March 14 at 7:00 pm

Author Cathy Hufault will present a picture show and discuss her book "Death Clouds on Mount Baldy".

The book documents three Boy Scouts that died in the Santa Rita Mountains in November 1958, when an unexpected storm dumped 3+ feet of snow overnight. Three of the six Boy Scouts who attempted to hike from Madera Canyon to Mount Wrightson died on the mountain and it took nineteen days to find their bodies. Three Boy Scouts survived and Cathy's twelve year old brother was one of them. The boys died within 3/8 miles of the Saddle off the Temporal Gulch Trail.

After reading the book last spring, the Dove Mountain Hikers were able to re-create the mistake the boys made and locate the location where they died.

Foot-note: **Cathy's twelve year old brother later had a son named Brian Coltrin who became a golf pro at Heritage Highlands.**
